Data On Teams

When Coach Lou Zarza's Green Wave machine trots out on the gridiron this afternoon a long record will either be lengthened or go into discard. For twenty-two years the Irish have not been vanquished in a Homecoming encounter. Last fall Viator whipped Jordan College 31-0.

McKendree, coached by E. B. "Sandy" Blanchard, has had a .500 season to date, winning two and losing the same number. The Green Wave has beaten Jordan 13-6, Carbondale, 14-0, and Kalamazoo 13-7. St. Ambrose triumphed over Viator 27-0 and Illinois Wesleyan battled the Irish to a 6-6 tie.

Coach Zarza has developed a potentially strong team using his variation of the Notre Dame shift. Captain Bill Walsh at right half has shown great qualities of leadership in the three games in which he has been able to participate. Bob Lenahan, chunky fullback from Vincennes, Indiana, has come through in tough spots despite an injury that would keep most players out of the game.

Danny Blazeovich, Little Nineteen end last year looks like a repeater because of his ability to snag the long passes hurled in his direction by the trusty arm of Luke Gleason, sensational sophomore left half.

John Morenc, sophomore center, has showed by his consistent play that he is one of the outstanding centers in the Midwest. A keen diagnostician, the South Bend youth is usually found at the bottom of every pileup. Another Hoosier, Anthony "Red" Zelencik, has won his way into the hearts of Viator fans by his phenomenal tackle play. The big, unassuming freshman has developed a little more in each game and by the end of the season should be one of Lou Zarza's most dependable linemen.

Ward at left half is supposedly one of the fastest and shiftiest backs in the Little Nineteen Conference this year. Besides being a good football player, he also plays a bit of basketball. He was an all state basketeer in '36.

Doener, giant red head who takes care of the right tackle berth has a reputation for stopping everything that comes his way. He tips the scales at a mere 210 pounds.

Danham, the other tackle, is nobody's slouch. Watch these two boys.

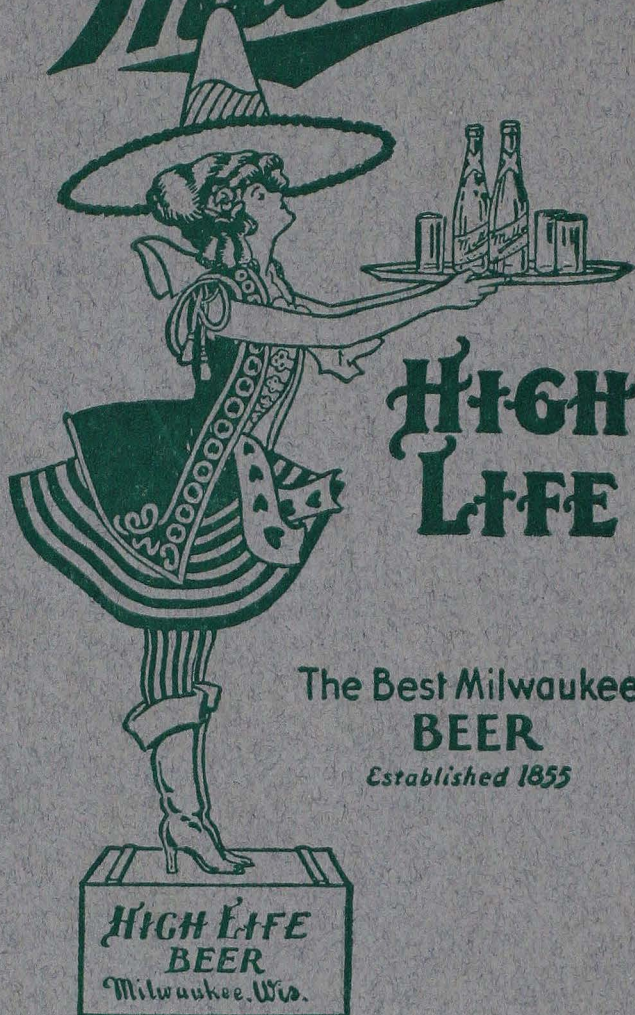
